If exam invigilation arrangements cannot be made with a CGA in your area, you must arrange to have an Association approved professional (i.e. C.A., CMA, teacher/professor, lawyer, medical doctor), accept the responsibility of invigilating a CGA examination. If an approved invigilator is not available, students will be responsible for travelling to the nearest CGA examination centre. Students are responsible for advising CIC of their special examination invigilator's name, full mailing address and telephone number above. Relatives and immediate employment supervisors are not eligible to supervise an exam. Students will be advised if their choice of invigilator does not meet the approval of the Association. **Exams must be written on the day and the time they are scheduled.**
